## **Relationship With Self**


Through the Flourish House Community, we commit to:

- Pursuing a deeper relationship with ourselves, our emotions and how we interact with the world
- Being honest and vocal about communicating emotional, physical, and relational needs
- Commit to individual discernment time in order to identify these needs and participate fully in the Flourish House community
- Prioritize personal growth and healthy personal development through intentional practices
- Maintain a personal space in a way that is respectful to the building and other house residents
- Set personal goals to hold the individual accountable to the Rule of Life

## Relationship With Each Other

Through the Flourish House Community, we commit to:

- Regular and intentional community time, both scheduled and unscheduled, for the purposes of building relationships with each other
- Regular Sabbath time that is separate from community time, for the purposes of debrief, check-in, and prayer
- Actively learn to and seek to create a space that encourages vulnerability, sharing, and mutual support



- Maintain common spaces in a way that is respectful to the building and other house residents
- Set communal goals to hold the community accountable to the Rule of Life

Relationship With Wider Community

Through the Flourish House Community, we commit to:

- Actively contribute to the life and work of the Eglinton St. George's community
- Regularly facilitate community building events that cater to a wide range of participants, oblates etc.
- Explore models of outreach and activism that are joy-filled and life-giving
- Discern and participate in specific mission or outreach projects that support the wider Toronto community
- Work towards maintaining a space that is accessible to and inclusive of all people

## Relationship With God

Through the Flourish House Community, we commit to:

- Individual and communal spiritual growth
- Create a safe space in which to discuss God, faith, and spirituality
- Live in accordance with the United Church's stated values in regards to peace, justice, and inclusion
- Exploring and developing a new monastic community that reflects the theology, history, and tradition of the United Church of Canada
- Espouse a belief system that acknowledges the validity and sacredness of all faith traditions

- Fully using the public transit options that the City of Toronto has to offer
- Maintain a plot in the ESG Community Garden
